



### **Canadian Beef Breed Memberships 2024**




### **Canadian Beef Breed Registrations 2024**








## **Registrations by Province**2020–2024











### **2024 THE by Province (%)**










## **Income (expressed as %)**

#### RICK & KATHRYN HAGEL -Beiseker, Alberta

"We use Simmental Bulls on our cow herd because we think they are the best balanced breed.

They have great performance from calving to weaning and carry on with that same performance in the feedlot which gives a high yielding carcass. They sire calves with good feet and legs and great milk in the females."



#### KODY HENRY, FAWN HILLS FARMS -Bassano, Alberta

"We have used Simmental in our herd for as long as

they have been in Canada. We have 250 Simmental influence cows and keep back approximately 50 replacement females each year. Our cow herd is made up of a Simmental/Red Angus cross, we like the disposition we get in our females from the Simmental, the momma cows have nice udders and are really good milkers! The Simmental cross calves have a lot of growth and power."

#### PAUL KEMPTER - Barriere, British Columbia

"Simmental cattle always seemed to work well for our operation. We have been very pleased with the overall breeding program of black Simmental bulls bred to mostly black, with red influence cows, the combination produces a nice moderate size cow with lots of maternal and she in turn produces a calf with lots of vigor"

#### MIKE WURZ - Sandhills Colony

"At Sandhills Colony our beef cattle herd consists of approximately 600 red and black Simmental influence cows. The Simmental influence provides us with a great crossbreed that gives our calves tons of performance and disposition that excel in the feedlot. We like the maternal strengths of the momma cow that provides our herd with good mothering abilities, longevity and lots of milk."

#### DAVE RAYMOND, RAYMOND LAND AND CATTLE - Aneroid, Saskatchewan

"It is a value-added opportunity for the ranch" says Dave Raymond. "Last year our half Simmental/Angus bred heifers fetched an average selling price of just under \$3,500 each at our annual bred heifer sale in early December". The Raymond's focus on improving the maternal traits in their herd. Growth is important, but they are also looking for traits that improve good milk production, easy calving, good temperament and easy keeping. "The cross breeding program with Simmental also ensures we are producing cattle with good feet and legs."

#### DAROLD AND KARA ENRIGHT, ENRIGHT CATTLE COMPANY -Tweed, Ontario

"We like the Simmental or SimmAngus cross because they finish nicely with some back fat and produce a nice carcass size." Says Kara Enright. As well since she works with the cattle quite a bit by herself and with their children in tow, Kara says she really appreciates the quiet temperament of Simmental cattle."

#### KEVIN ROUTLEDGE - Hamiota, Manitoba

In the mid-1980s the Routledge family introduced Simmental bulls to their herd and the transition to Simmental influenced cattle began. The beef herd which has expanded over the years, has long-relied on Simmental genetics to produce calves with higher weaning weights in the fall. "I like the fact that compared to the earlier days, the breed has produced a moderate sized animal, we select replacement Simmental influenced females based on good temperament, good milk production and mothering ability."

#### JEFF & LAURIE MILLER - Calgary, Alberta

"We like keeping back Simmental cross heifers for replacement females because of their maternal quality, they always have good udders and great milking ability. Our Simmental crossbreeding program has also provided us with lower birth weights and high performance in our calves each year.


The Simmental influence calves we keep in the feedlot have some of the best marbling and yield grades. These calves always do well on feed and don't get excessively fat like some other cattle can.


"We use Simmental Bulls in our commercial herd because they










## % OF TOTAL PROMOTIONAL FUNDING SIMMENTAL




#### **RFID Monthly Tag Sales Yearly Comparison**

## CSA AWARD OF EXCELLENCE RULES AND REGULATIONS



- ➤ All animals that are exhibited in any CSA Award of Excellence show must be registered or recorded with the CSA.
- As per the CSA's bylaws, all animals need to be tattooed before they are six months of age. Although the animals are welcome to complete in the show, animals that are not properly registered or have tattoos upon the arrival of the participating show will be ineligible to compete for AOE points.
- ➤ Young Canadian Simmental Association shows do not qualify for the AOE.
- Cattle exhibiting in designated AOE shows are encouraged but not required to be tagged with a Canadian Simmental RFID back button tag.
- Complete and accurate show results must be submitted to the CSA office no later than two weeks after their respective provincial show.


