



National Classic Travel Assistance Funding

In partnership with the Friends of Canadian Simmental Foundation, the Young Canadian Simmental Association is offering travel bursaries to assist National Classic participants with travel-related costs. The goal is to encourage as many young Simmental enthusiasts as possible across Canada to participate in the National Classic.

How do you apply:

- 1) National Classic participants travelling for outside of the Maritime region may apply.
- 2) Participants must be registered and participate in the 2026 YCSA National Classic.
- 3) Participants make the funding request on their registration form.
- 4) Participants travel will be calculated based on the location input on the registration form.
- 5) Funding decisions and amount awarded will be based on the total number of applicants, and distance travelled. Decisioning will be at the sole discretion of the YCSA, based on an equitable and transparency funding model that is applied consistently across the applicant pool. Final funding decisions will be made by August 15th and communicated to all eligible recipients.

The National Classic will be held July 23 - 26, 2025, in Annapolis Valley, Nova Scotia.
